MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT

It is my honor to invite you to participate in the 31st Annual Armed Forces Day observance to be held at Andrews Air Force Base on May 10.

I believe the occasion, which kicks off a nationwide observance, offers an excellent opportunity for you, our Commander in Chief, to address U.S. Military men and women worldwide. The address would be scheduled for noon.

This year, the event will include aerial demonstrations by the Air Force Thunderbirds and other aircraft, a mass paradrop, and numerous static displays and exhibits. Last year's program was attended by more than 200,000 people.
