Dear Mr. President:

Following our meeting in Detroit on July 8, questions have been asked with some frequency about the progress being made in resolving government-related problems affecting our industry. In my mind, there is no doubt that you have made an important beginning in developing a more constructive relationship between government and business. In my public statements, I have emphasized the significance of your leadership in this effort.

As time passes, the questions have become more specific. Thus, it would be helpful if some further, significant steps would be taken by the Administration which we could cite as real progress. Unfortunately, the actions announced so far by the Environmental Protection Agency, while welcome, do not represent a significant cost savings. Other actions which we have anticipated have not materialized. And several of our requests or petitions to agencies regarding specific regulations have been denied. In some cases, it appears that while, at the policy level in your Administration, there is a desire and interest to make real progress, this progress simply does not occur. Adjustment of the passive restraint standard, which now favors imports over domestic cars, is a case in point since neither the Department of Transportation nor the Congress have yet taken the needed corrective action.

We have supplied Administration officials with a comprehensive and detailed listing of regulatory actions which can be taken administratively and which would make a significant contribution to capital formation by avoiding unnecessary investment or additional cost to the consumer. We have been careful to suggest changes we fully believe would not have a significant adverse effect on safety or the environment.

Let me cite examples of how significant regulatory relief can be. By maintaining current test procedures for heavy duty truck emissions in lieu of EPA's proposed changes, GM alone could save

without adversely affecting public health, about \$100 million otherwise required for new test facilities and tooling. (In addition, the more stringent standards are expected to add \$1,200 to the initial cost of a gasoline engine truck and \$1,700 to its lifetime operating costs.) Also, by revising the New Source Performance Standard for new industrial boilers to allow the use of our newly developed Side-Stream Separator and low-sulphur fuel, about \$150 million in pollution control investment would be saved with no impact on air quality. The combined capital savings for these two regulatory changes is one quarter of a billion dollars which is the capital investment needed to build a production module of four-cylinder engines with a capacity of 1,600 engines per day, employing about 1,200 persons.

Meeting the stringent emissions levels and test procedures for the 1984 light-duty truck emissions standards, just signed by the EPA Administrator, will require use of unleaded gasoline, a catalytic converter and one catalyst change to meet the useful life requirements. While we appreciate the extension by EPA of the effective date from 1983 to 1984, failure of EPA to modify the requirements in the way we suggested will cost a new GM truck purchaser in the area of \$60 per vehicle initially and later up to \$300 per vehicle. If GM sells 1.5 million light-duty trucks subject to these requirements, these rules will cost consumers around \$500 million for those vehicles. The magnitude of this cost can be illustrated by the fact that it is roughly equivalent to the amount of money it would cost GM to build a modern 75-passenger-car-per-hour assembly plant with around 5,000 employees. These are but two examples.

We have been encouraged by your interest and concern and have appreciated the opportunity to discuss our problems with you, Secretary Goldschmidt and others. We welcome the regulatory changes which have been made, but strongly urge that more significant action be taken as soon as possible. I sincerely believe this is necessary to maintain the momentum you have begun in your approach to our government-related problems.

I want again to express my appreciation for your initiatives and to assure you that all of us at General Motors are dedicated to the achievement of a more constructive relationship in meeting public as well as corporate goals.
