


The following oath was duly administered to JIMMY CARTER
at the United States Capitol, Washington, D.C., on Thursday,
January 20, 1977, at 12 o'clock noon:

I, JIMMY CARTER, DO SOLEMNLY SWEAR THAT I WILL
FAITHFULLY EXECUTE THE OFFICE OF PRESIDENT OF
THE UNITED STATES, AND WILL TO THE BEST OF MY
ABILITY, PRESERVE, PROTECT AND DEFEND THE CON-
STITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES. SO HELP ME GOD.
