MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT

FROM JOE CALIFANO *JCF*

SUBJECT: Meeting with Chief State School Officers

At our education briefing for you in December, you suggested that we bring the Chief State School Officers to Washington for a discussion of the Administration's plans for reauthorizing the elementary and secondary legislation. That meeting with you is now set for the evening of January 11th.

I suggest the following schedule.

Afternoon. Briefings at HEW by me, Assistant Secretary Berry and Commissioner Boyer on the legislative program (including alternatives where there has not yet been final EOP clearance) and on administrative changes in the Office of Education. We will solicit extensive comments from the Chiefs at that time.

Dinner. After the briefings, we will serve dinner at HEW.

Post-Dinner. I would suggest that we then bus the Chiefs to the White House for coffee (arrival time 7:45). You could then come in about 8 p.m. and meet with them informally for 10-15 minutes. After you welcome them to the White House and speak about your goal of basic skills and functional literacy (we will provide talking points), I will briefly (3-4 charts, 5 minutes) summarize the points presented to the Chiefs in the afternoon session. You could then solicit their comments on legislative, administrative and other matters for 30-40 minutes and the meeting can end around 9 p.m.

This schedule makes the most efficient use of your time, and should still provide the Chiefs with ample opportunity to share their most important observations with you.
