### **Public Radio's Krista Tippett on "SPEAKING OF FAITH"**

**ATLANTA, GA.** - Public Radio host Krista Tippett will discuss her new book "Speaking of Faith" at a very special lecture and book signing on Friday, March 9th at the Carter Presidential Center. The 7 p.m. presentation is sponsored by the Carter Presidential Library and A Cappella Books and is open to the public at no charge. Doors to the Carter Center's Ivan Allen Pavilion opens at 6 p.m.

WABE's Valerie Jackson will tape her popular radio program "Between the Lines" with Ms. Tippett before the live Carter Center audience. Following the taping, Ms. Tippett will answer audience questions and sign copies of her new book. A Cappella Books will have copies of "Speaking of Faith" for sale at the event.

Tippett draws on her life experiences and her studies, as well as on conversations with Elie Wiesel, Karen Armstrong, Thich Nhat Hanh, and other renowned figures, to explore such complex subjects as justice, science, fundamentalism, evil, love, and mystery, all within the context of spirituality.

Tippett's unique, in-depth conversations with theologians, scientists, ethicists, and seekers who share their experiences, combined with her engaging style, are revolutionizing the way many think and speak of faith in their families and communities and in the larger world.
